Thousands of firework injuries are treated in U.S. hospital emergency departments every year often leaving permanent damage to eyes, hands & face. Over 50% of firework injuries occur in people under the age of 20 years old.

## AVOID SPARKLERS



Sparklers can reach temperatures greater than 1,200 degrees Fahrenheit —hotter than a blowtorch! The best way to avoid a burn injury from a sparkler is to avoid them altogether.
